


Bayou Gulch at Two Bridges

General Information

The Bayou Gulch Trail winds 10 miles through gently rolling, prairie terrain. The area features upland grasslands and unique riparian areas. The trail connects to the Cherry Creek Regional Trail and Bayou Gulch Regional Park. The Bayou Gulch Open Space is leased to the Colorado Horse Park.

Public access is limited to designated trails, horse jumps are not for public use. Access is allowed under agreement with the Horse Park and will be limited during scheduled events.

Respect Wildlife

Pronghorn, snakes and many other wildlife species call this land home.

Directions

Turn East from Parker Road on Bayou Gulch Road and drive 1.2 miles to Fox Sparrow Road. Turn left on to Fox Sparrow Road and drive 0.5 miles to park at the Bayou Gulch Regional Park. The Bayou Gulch Open Space is accessible from the Bayou Gulch Park trails, across Bayou Gulch Road.
