ALL INSPECTIONS ARE REQUIRED TO BE SCHEDULED THROUGH THE PERMITS STAFF. (303) 660-7487
PLEASE SCHEDULE ALL WORK THROUGH THE PERMITS DESK AND NOT THE INSPECTOR.

JOBSITE INFORMATION -

* No work is allowed onsite, other than the installation of the initial BMP's, as shown on the GESC Plan, until the GESC/DESC Permit is issued following the preconstruction meeting.

* The Douglas County GESC/DESC Permits, and Douglas County approved plans are required to be kept onsite at all times.

* The GESC Manager shall be present at the project site a majority of the time and (along with the alternate GESC Manager), shall provide the County with a 24-hour emergency contact number.

* Notification in writing shall be provided to the County documenting any change of personnel for the GESC Manager or alternate GESC Manager.

MANDATORY COUNTY GESC INSPECTIONS -

* Preconstruction Meeting/Inspection

* Any time a new GESC Manager/Alternate GESC Manager is selected.

* Prior to issuance of a County Right-of-Way Use and Construction Permit for curb and gutter or construction of roadways.

* Prior to any waterline flushing.

* Initial Close-out Inspection prior to the Certification of Occupancy or Temporary Certificate of Occupancy, or prior to the transition to the DESC Program for single family residential projects.

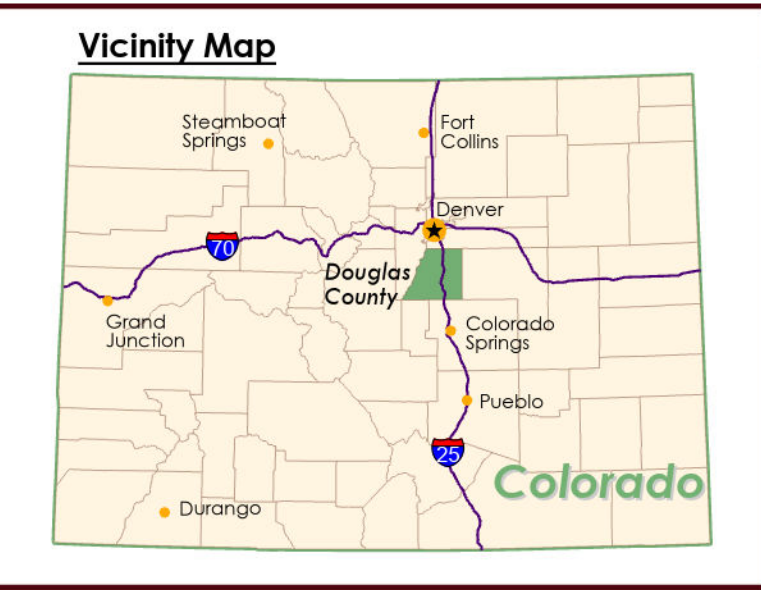
* Vegetation Acceptance Inspection.

* Final Close-out Inspection
